<p>Spread of Avian Influenza between birds whilst on the farm.</p>	<p>Wild and captive birds.</p>	<p><b>Spread of Avian Influenza between wild and captive birds.</b></p>	<p>All branches of Incredible Eggs have conducted risk assessments to ensure their on-site practices are Avian Influenza Secure. These include:</p> <p>All branch farms are registered on the Poultry Register of Great Britain.</p> <p>All birds, stored eggs, bedding, feed and hatching equipment are kept in places that wild birds cannot access.</p> <p>All hatching equipment is thoroughly sterilised between settings.</p> <p>Movement on our branch farms of people, vehicles and equipment into or out of areas intended for birds/eggs/equipment has been reduced to a minimum.</p> <p>Written records relating to movement are kept.</p> <p>Integrity of buildings where birds are kept is checked daily for defects.</p> <p>Bird health is closely and regularly monitored on a daily basis.</p> <p>Strict husbandry hygiene measures are in place.</p>	<p>Ongoing monitoring of standards.</p>	<p>Incredible Eggs Branch Manager.</p>

<p>Spread of Avian Influenza between birds during the hire period.</p>	<p>Wild and captive birds.</p>	<p><b>Spread of Avian Influenza between wild and captive birds.</b></p>	<p>Any person handling eggs, hatched birds, feed or bedding should wash hands both before and after with soap and water/use a high alcohol hand sanitiser.</p> <p>Eggs and hatched birds must be kept indoors for the duration of the hire period to ensure they do not come into contact with captive birds, wild birds or their droppings.</p>	<p>Kit box to be accessed only by those who have followed Measure 4.</p> <p>Frequently touched surfaces to be regularly cleaned with a sanitising agent. These include the outside of the incubator and the outside of the brooding cage. Surfaces should be wiped and not sprayed to avoid inhalation by the hatchlings or contamination of toxic substances to their living environment. <p>Spread of Avian Influenza between birds during the hire period.</p>	<p>Wild and captive birds.</p>	<p>Spread of Avian Influenza between wild and captive birds.</p>	<p><b>Weekend care</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The complete kit and hatchlings may go home with a member of staff/responsible adult but must be kept indoors (or in their brooding cage when being transported) for the duration of the hire period to ensure they do not come into contact with other captive birds, wild birds or their droppings.</li> <li>2) The complete kit may remain within the setting and tended to by any staff member/responsible adult but must be kept indoors for the duration of the hire period to ensure they do not come into contact with other captive birds, wild birds or their droppings.</li> <li>3) Where an outbreak of bird flu has been identified, a 10km zone is temporarily put in place around the outbreak by the government. No eggs or birds may be moved into or out of this zone until it is removed. We will have checked that settings are not located within a zone where the movement of eggs or birds is prohibited prior to delivery.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Any person handling eggs, hatched birds, feed or bedding should wash hands both before and after with soap and water/use a high alcohol hand sanitiser.</li> <li>2) Any person handling eggs, hatched birds, feed or bedding should wash hands both before and after with soap and water/use a high alcohol hand sanitiser.</li> <li>3) Any movement of birds or eggs during or after the hire period MUST NOT be either into or out of one of these zones.
