Kit box to be accessed only by those who have followed Measure 4.  Frequently touched surfaces to be regularly cleaned with a sanitising agent. These include the outside of the incubator and the outside of the brooding cage. Surfaces should be wiped and not sprayed to avoid inhalation by the hatchlings or contamination of toxic substances to their living environment. Touching of these surfaces by anyone other than the supervising adult to be discouraged.	Supervising classroom teacher/ manager/responsible adult.

Weekend care  1) The complete kit and hatchlings may go home with a member of staff/responsible adult but must be kept indoors (or in their brooding cage when being transported) for the duration of the hire period to ensure they do not come into contact with other captive birds, wild birds or their droppings.	1)	Any person handling eggs, hatched birds, feed or bedding should wash hands both before and after with soap and water/use a high alcohol hand sanitiser.	Supervising classroom teacher/ manager/responsible adult.
			2) The complete kit may remain within the setting and tended to by any staff member/responsible adult but must be kept indoors for the duration of the hire period to ensure they do not come into contact with other captive birds, wild birds or their droppings.	2)	Any person handling eggs, hatched birds, feed or bedding should wash hands both before and after with soap and water/use a high alcohol hand sanitiser.	Supervising classroom teacher/manager/responsible adult.
			3) Where an outbreak of bird flu has been identified, a 10km zone is temporarily put in place around the outbreak by the government. No eggs or birds may be moved into or out of this zone until it is removed. We will have checked that settings are not located within a zone where the movement of eggs or birds is prohibited prior to delivery.	3)	Any movement of birds or eggs during or after the hire period MUST NOT be either into or out of one of these zones.
